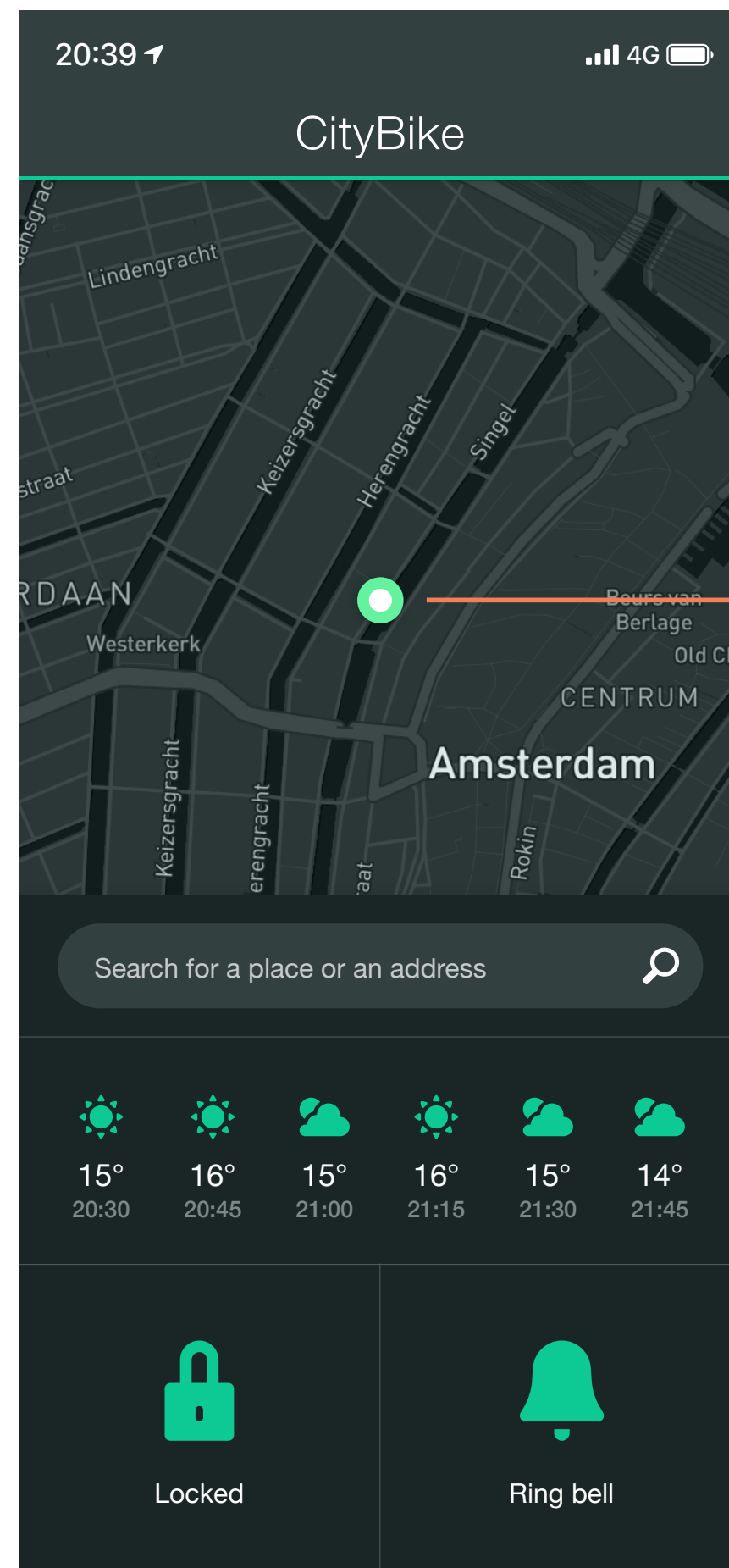


Routing

Objective: Input the destination and select a route



- Users weren't sure if the green dot was them or the bike.
Try showing the user's location as well in this view.

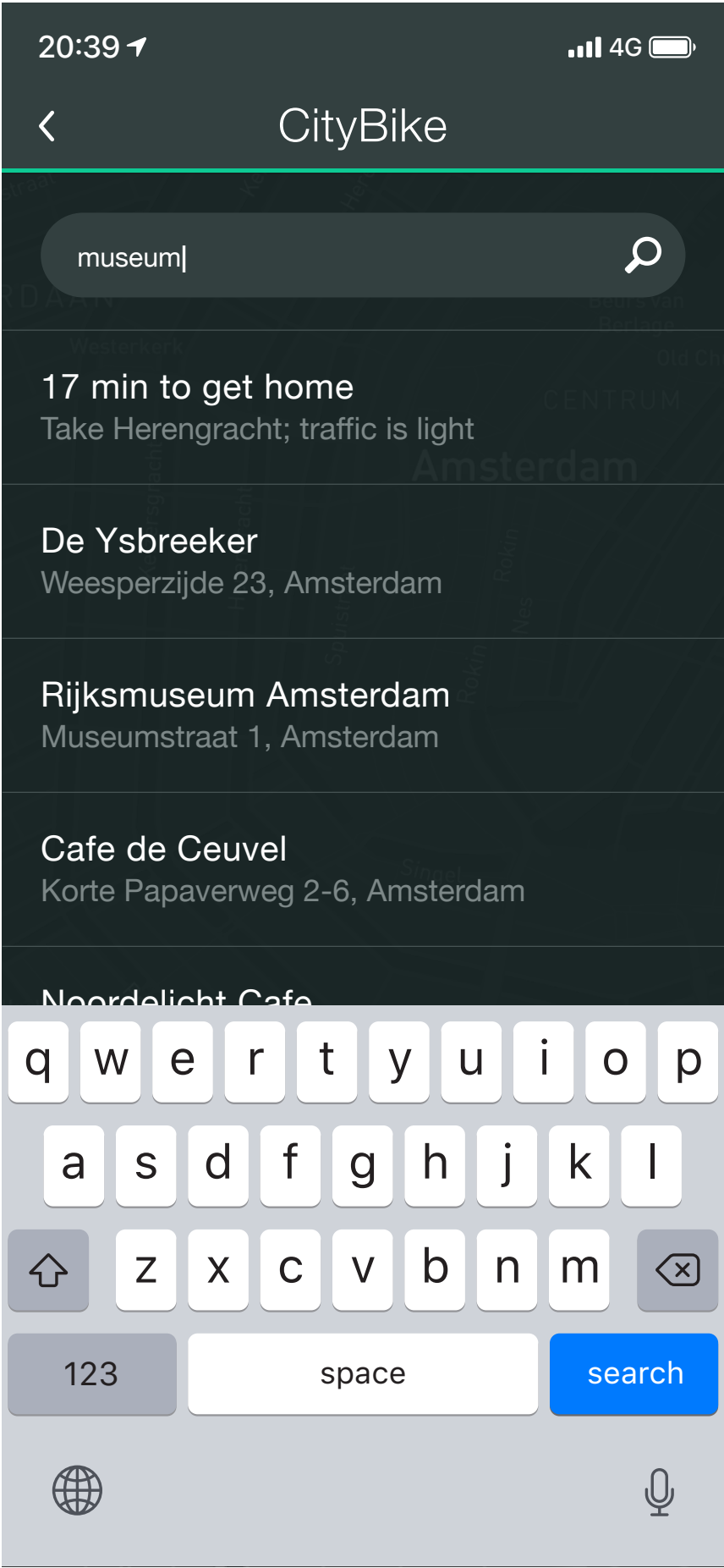
- The address search was intuitive to all users.

- Many users commented on how useful the weather visualization was.
- One user mentioned that he would use the app just to check the weather!

- Half of the users didn't realize that they could scroll for more information.
Try adding a peek of lower content to make this more obvious.

Routing

Objective: Input the destination and select a route

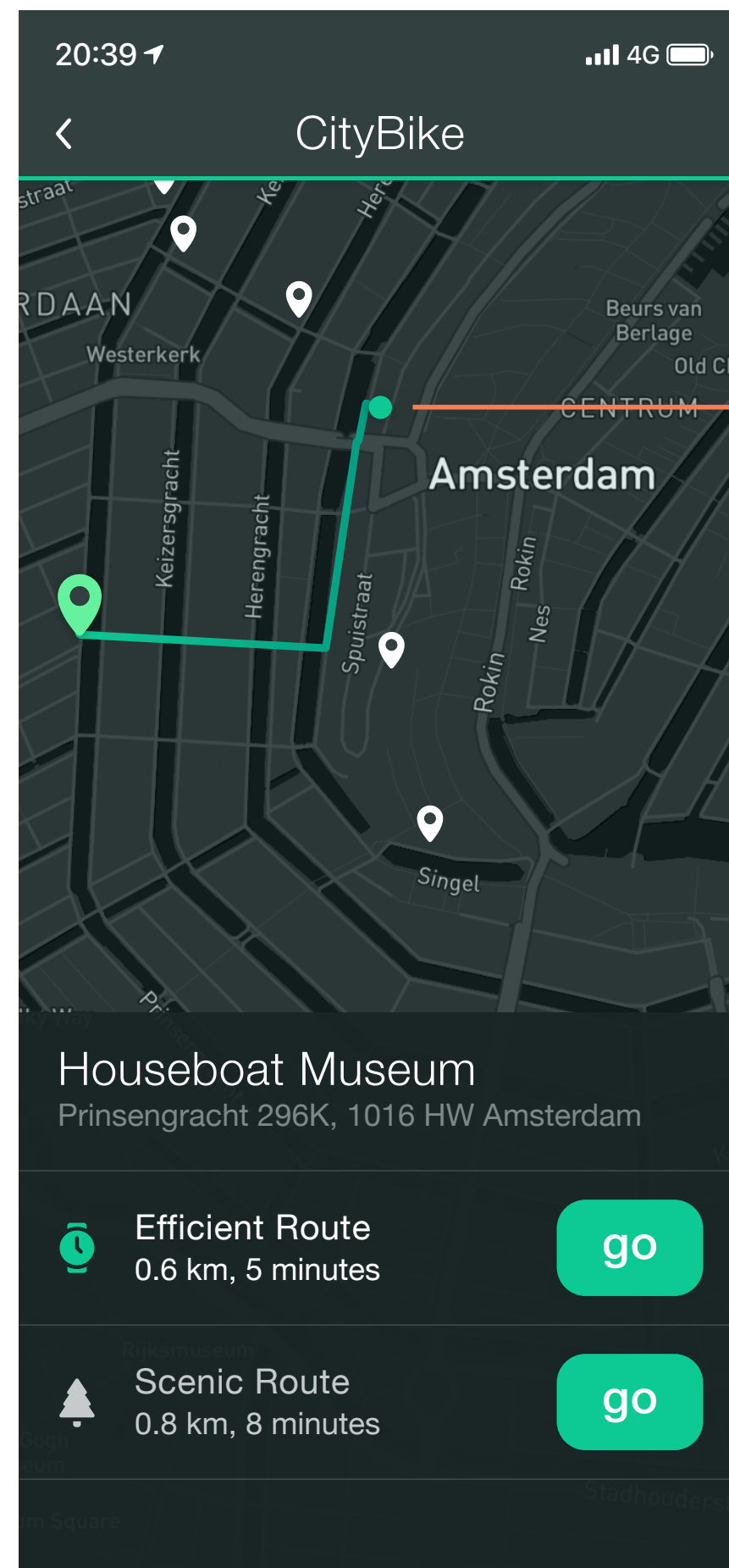


- One user mentioned wanting an easy way to clear all contents from the search field. *Try replacing the “search” icon with an “x” seen on the next screen.*

- Seventy-five percent of users tapped on the destination from this screen.

Routing

Objective: Input the destination and select a route

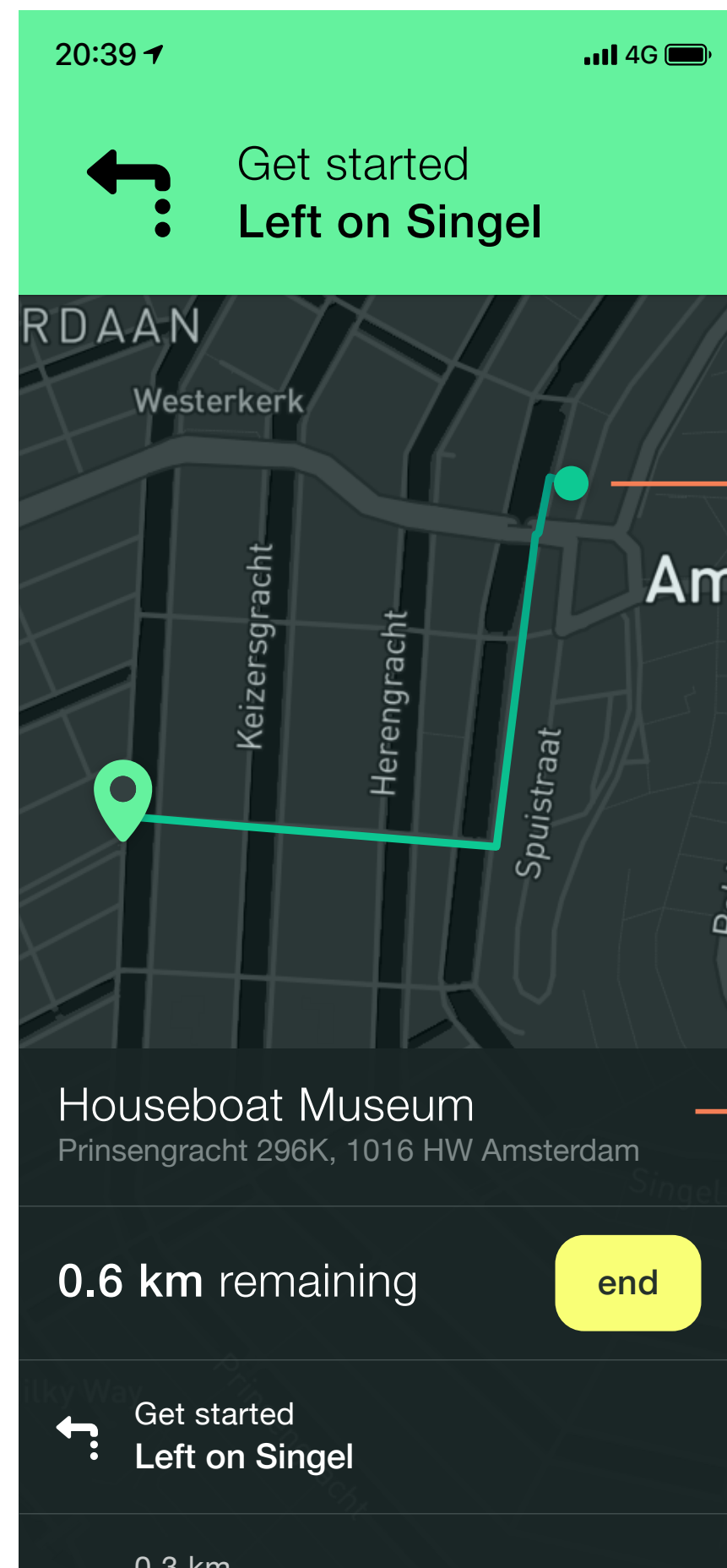


- Four users couldn't tell which was the starting point and which was the destination.
Make the starting point more consistent with "current location" indicator from previous screens.

- Most users tried to switch routes.
- Two users complained that it wasn't obvious enough which route was selected.

Using Directions

Objective: Use directions to get to your destination



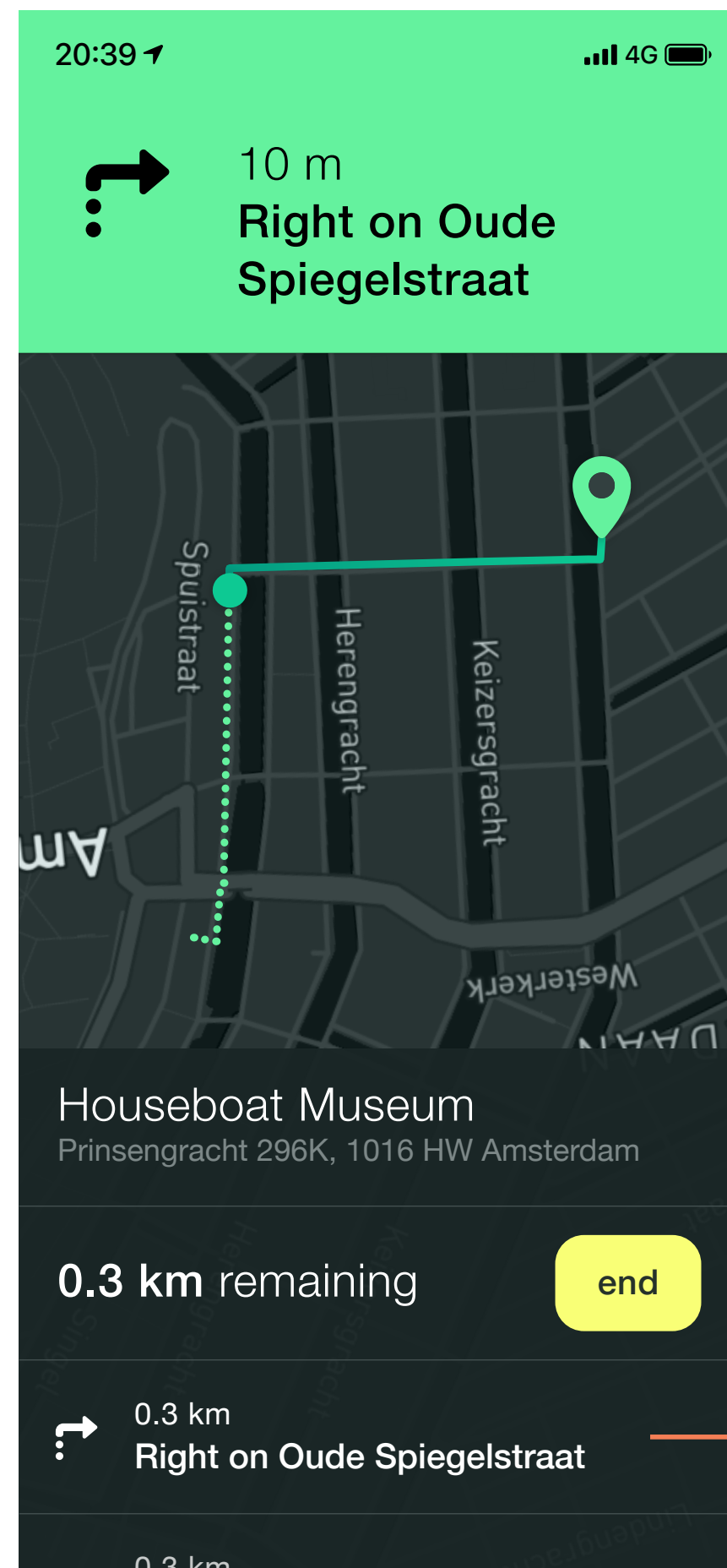
- One user suggested adding a way to minimize instructions without fully leaving the screen.

- Two users couldn't tell which dot was the current location and which was the destination.
- Many users had a difficult time orienting at first.
Try adding a point showing direction to the location dot.

- One user was frustrated that he couldn't change the route from this screen.
Try adding a back button for the user to easily adjust his route.

Using Directions

Objective: Use directions to get to your destination

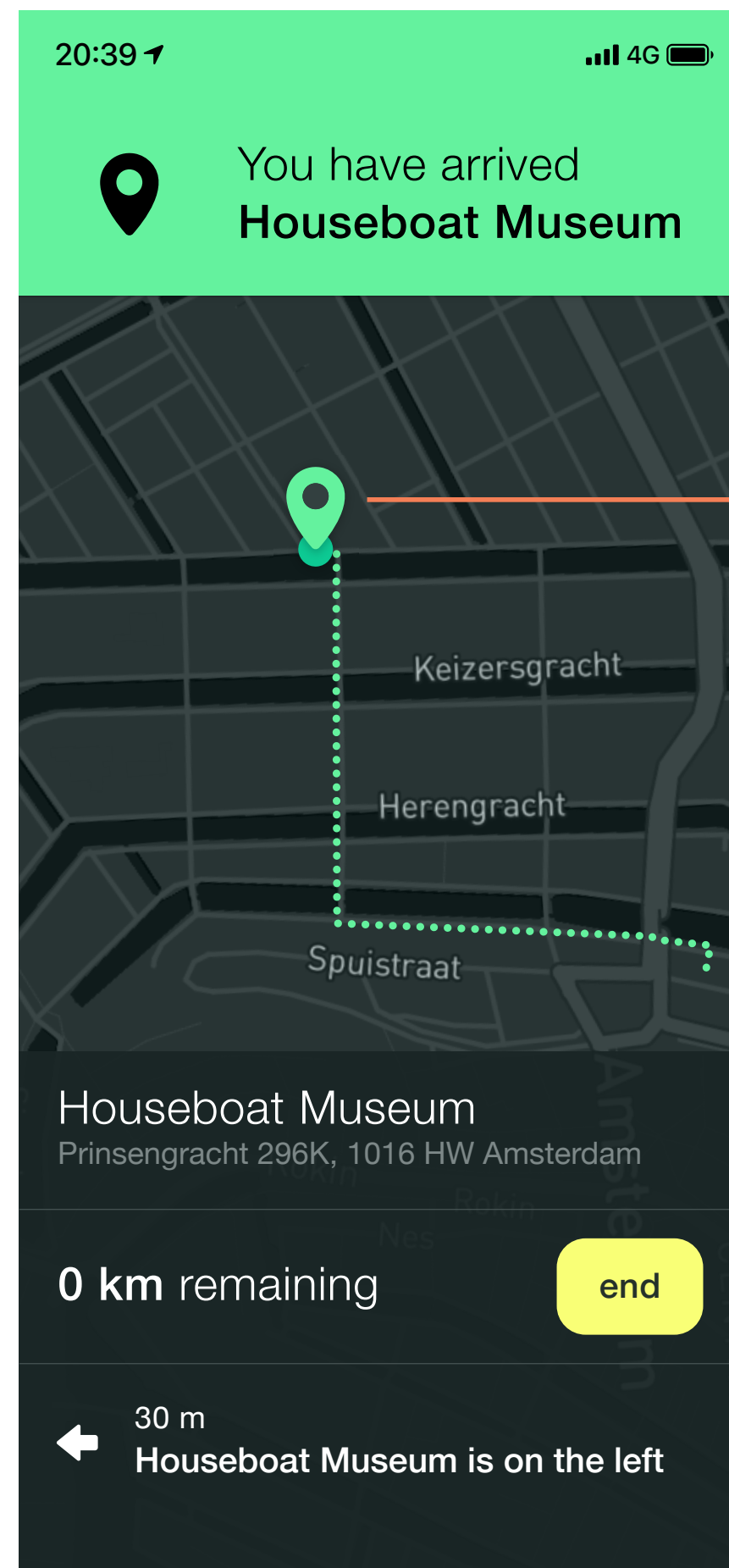


- Eight users were confused when the map rotated with their orientation.
- About half of users wanted a way to lock the map's orientation.
Try adding a compass icon to show current direction and to lock direction (similar to other mapping tools).

- One user thought it was confusing to see nonupdating directions here.
- Two users wanted access to all of the directions, even after the trip had begun.

Using Directions

Objective: Use directions to get to your destination



- Two users complained that it wasn't obvious enough when they'd reached their destination.
Try changing color or adding an effect that shows when the user has reached their destination.

- Most users thought it was weird that they still needed to end directions after they'd reached their destination.
Add a timeout after the user reaches their destination.
