

Comparative Bar Chart (not mobile)

Title

Chart titles can wrap up to two lines. They use the "Chart Title" style in Black.

Y-Axis Labels

A chart may have one or two y-axis labels. Label area is 1/12 the total width of the chart, with the remaining width left for the visualization.

Visualizations always use five Y-axis labels, dynamically generated based on the data set.

Axis labels use the "Chart Label" style in Black.

Legend

Only for charts visualizing multiple data sets, the legend adds 40 px. to the height of the chart.

Legend color dots have a 12 px. diameter. It's 8 px. from the color dot to the text, and 30 px. between items.

Typography is "Chart Legend" style in Black.

Visualizations

Visualizations should use Turquoise, then Yellow, and then Neutral palettes for visualizing multiple data types. They should not visualize more than three types of data.

Horizontal dividing lines are 1 px. solid Light Gray.

Bars are 80% opacity. Turquoise bars are Dark Turquoise at the top and Turquoise at the bottom.

Daffodil bars are Dark Daffodil at the top and Daffodil at the bottom.

Neutral bars are Darkest Gray at the top and Dark Gray at the bottom.

Reservation Card

Additional Details

Names are limited to one line before being truncated with an ellipsis.

Email and phone number are optional. Without name and phone number, distance to notes is 15 px. If there are no notes, distance to buttons is 20 px.

Notes can wrap up to four lines before being truncated with an ellipsis. If there are no notes, the distance between reservation information and text buttons is 20 px.

Cards are stacked vertically with 10 px. between them.

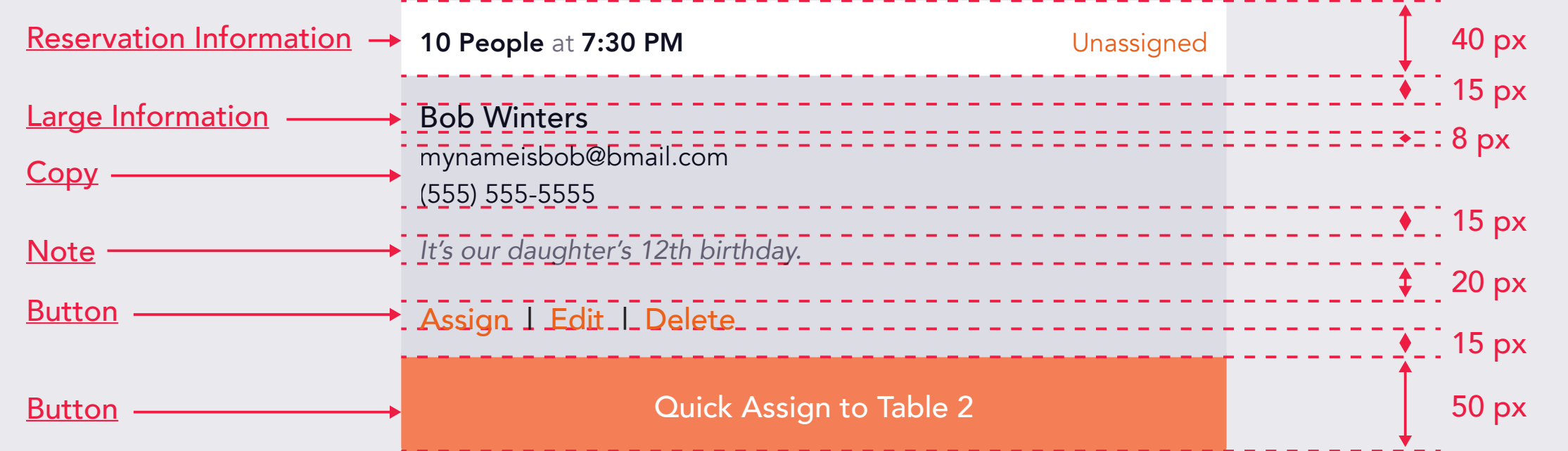

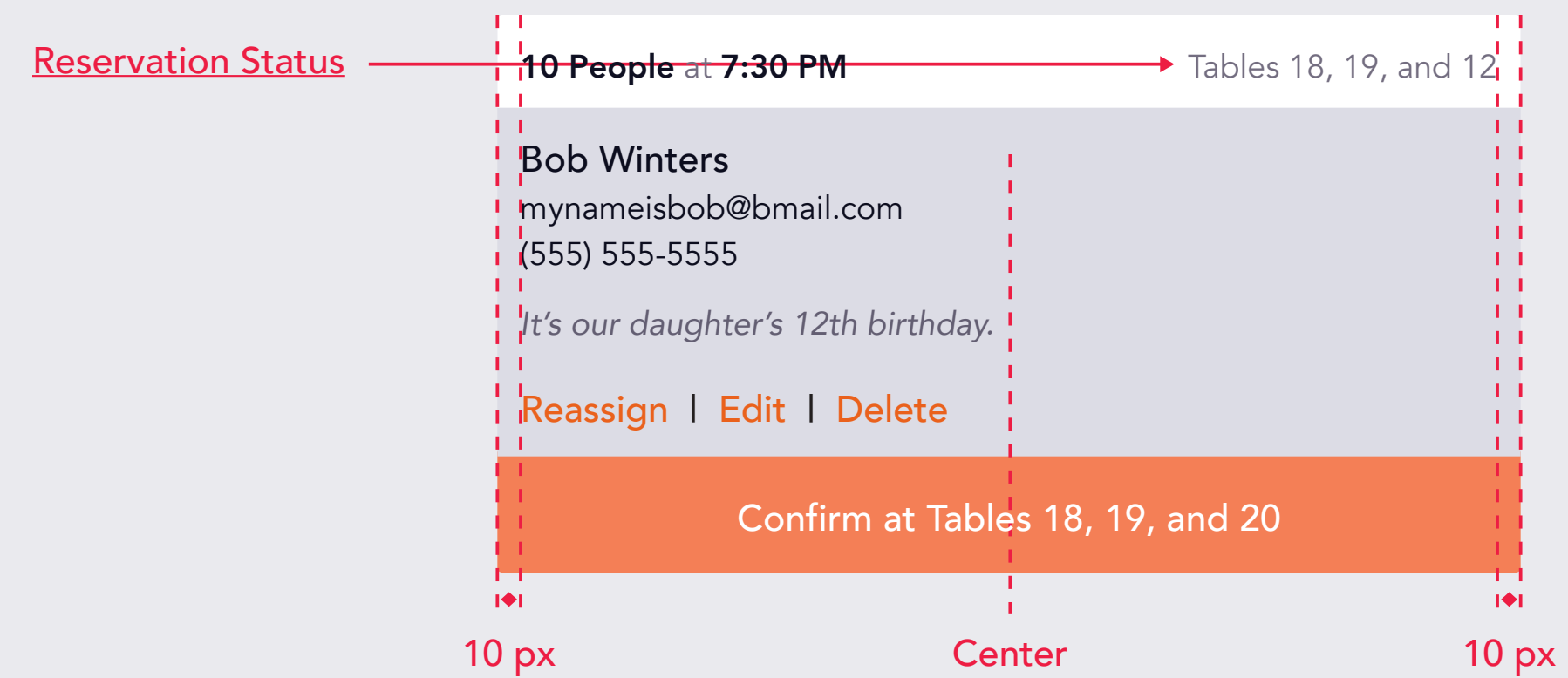
